BY-LAW NO. 1706/14

Being a By-law to create a Reduced-Speed School Zone
within the Town of Beausejour

WHEREAS, Section 98.1 of the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013 authorize a council to pass by-laws establishing the reduced maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven on a highway within a school zone within the geographic boundaries of a municipality;

AND WHEREAS, the Town of Beausejour deems it advisable and in the best interests of the Town to establish school zones with a reduced maximum speed for vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Beausejour enacts as a by-law the following:

1. Interpretation

For the purposes of this By-law, "highway", "reduced-speed school zone", "school", "school property", "traffic control device", and "vehicle" have the same meanings as set out in the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.

2. Establishment of reduced-speed school zones

The following portions of highways are designated as reduced-speed school zones with reduced maximum permitted speed:

- a. Ecole Edward Schreyer School, 85 Fifth Street South, Beausejour, Manitoba.

Highways included in the reduced-speed school zone:

That portion of Fifth Street beginning at the point where the CPR right of way intersects with Fifth Street and continuing in a northerly direction and ending at the point where Fifth Street and Ashton Avenue intersect.

3. Maximum permitted speed within reduced-speed school zones

The maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven in a reduced-speed school zone on a highway is:

- a. 30 km/h

4. Times when the reduced-speed school zones apply

The reduced maximum permitted speeds established under section 4 apply within a reduced-speed school zone from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday from September 1st through to and including June 30th.


5. Traffic control devices

The Municipality shall identify a reduced-speed school zone with traffic control devices that comply with the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.
